Second of some 24 children (and first son) of the sovereign - one of the richest in the world - and Prime Minister of Dubai, the funeral took place the same evening at the Zabeel mosque. The Emirate of Dubai currently observed three days of mourning following the death of the eldest son of Mohammed bin Rashid Al Maktoum, Vice President, Prime Minister of the UAE and Ruler of Dubai. Crown Prince of Abu Dhabi Sheikh Mohamed bin Zayed Al Nahyan led the procession, and several of the deceased's brothers carried his coffin, covered with the national flag. It now rests in the cemetery Umm Hurair, Al Fahidi, in the historic district of Bur Dubai, while the national three-day mourning declared Saturday that saw the official Condolences pour in from throughout the Arab world, will be coming to an end.

Upset at the funeral, Sheikh Hamdan, the nearest of nine brothers Rashid, born a year after her also of Sheikha Hind, paid a moving tribute to his eldest via his Instagram account: "Today I lost a best friend and a childhood companion. My dear brother Rashid, we will miss you, "wrote one who is since 2008 the crown prince of Dubai title. An accomplished sportsman and notorious fan of football, especially Manchester United, he agreed with Dubai Cares, an organisation that aims to provide access to education for underprivileged children around the world.
